

# PATHWAY TO CRIP

## CRIP Scheduling Starts December 7th

You must have paid the CRIP fee and the program(s) have granted you an interview in order to schedule. Log onto [www.CASPRweb.org](http://www.CASPRweb.org), and go to the "CRIP" tab. Select "Create/Modify Schedule." From the drop-down at the top of the tab, select the section you are scheduling. A list of programs interviewing at CRIP during that period that have granted you interviews will appear, along with the days they are interviewing. Programs are not available every day.

Click on a program to bring up the interview schedule. You may need to scroll side to side to see all of the interviews available. Interviews that have already been taken will be blocked. Click on the interview time you wish to schedule. Once you get confirmation that the interview has been scheduled, it will be added to the schedule on the "Create/Modify" screen.

You must allow at least 30 minutes between interviews. Programs can start interviews as early as 8 am and go into the evening. If the program plans callbacks and socials, they will show on your PDF schedule after selecting a time. If you encounter problems, contact our office immediately.

### Crunch Time!

**November 2, 2009:** Stage II deadline. Make sure all of the letters of recommendation (LORs) and other documents you will like to include in your electronic application are uploaded. Proofread carefully Part I and Part II to make sure everything is correct. Log on to [www.CASPRweb.org](http://www.CASPRweb.org) to confirm that the "Application Complete" box is checked off in the status section and to review your designations.

**November 9, 11:59 pm Eastern:** The initial designation deadline for CASPR at which time the CASPRweb.org site will shut down for a week. While the site is shut down, you will not be able to access your account. While applications not marked "Application Complete" can be finished and designations made after the site comes back up, anything after November 9<sup>th</sup> is considered late!

**November 16:** Completed CASPR applications will be delivered to programs. Programs will begin reviewing applications and granting interviews. Check your account under "My Programs" for interviews granted and notes from programs.

Any fees or additional materials required by the programs not delivered with your CASPR application should be sent directly to the program. The address to use is listed on the program directory page. The deadline for receipt of supplemental materials is November 16<sup>th</sup>. Include a cover letter that state you are applying for a residency position for the 2010-2011 training year.
