

PATHWAY TO CRIP

Bi-Monthly Newsletters

As we prepare for the consolidated CRIP in January, the CRIP office will be sending bi-monthly newsletters with information to assist you in planning for the upcoming CRIP in Frisco, TX. These newsletters will contain tips and suggestions regarding scheduling interviews, travel logistics and amenities. This is a very busy time so we want to ensure that everyone has the information they need to make the selection process successful. These newsletters are also available on www.casprcrip.org.

CRIP Attendance

CRIP will be January 12-17, 2012. It is divided into two sections, three days each. Programs from the west and south will participate in Section I, while programs from the northeast are in Section II. Be sure to check the CASPR Directory to confirm the section your programs will attend.

Because of a regional meeting being held the third week of January, programs from the south, including Florida, Alabama, North Carolina, Tennessee, Louisiana and Georgia will attend Section I.

Hotels and Transportation

Although the majority of interviews will be held Fri-Mon, you should plan to arrive after 3pm the day prior to your first section of interviews. DVAs will hold their interviews mainly on Thurs or Tues. Allow time on the last day of interviews, either Sat or Tues, for possible call-backs. Do not plan to depart before noon.

Because all interview rooms must be at the Embassy Suites, no student block is available. We have arranged student blocks at nearby hotels. Contact information for the hotels, a link to make reservations and a map can be found in the CRIP section of the Instruction Booklet. Each hotel has shuttle service available between the CRIP hotel and their hotel.

The hotel is located equidistant from both the Dallas/Fort Worth airport and Love Field (a SouthWest hub). Attendees will need to arrange transportation from the airport to the hotel, about 20 miles away. We have negotiated a reduced rate with the Yellow Checker Shuttle company and an additional discount is available if reservations are made online, a savings of over 35% off the regular price.
