PROGRAM OVERVIEW

DVA San Francisco is an affiliate of the University of California, San Francisco. The residency program utilizes training resources at VASF/UCSF, Healdsburg District Hosp, and Kaiser Permanente Walnut Creek/Antioch, (Kaiser San Francisco Bay Area Foot & Ankle Residency Program). Training encompasses all areas of foot and ankle surgery including trauma, reconstruction, pediatrics, diabetic limb salvage and diabetic wound care. The program has recently collaborated with Kaiser Permanente Walnut Creek and Antioch Medical Centers for rotations through the San Francisco Bay Area Foot & Ankle Residency Program. Additional outside surgical centers including Healdsburg District Hosp (Dr. Thomas Chang, Dr. Michael Cosenza, Dr. Walter D'Costa, Dr. Jonathan Kreger). DVA San Francisco provides a well rounded Podiatric Medicine and Surgery residency program in the San Francisco Bay Area.
