**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The Podiatric Residency Program (PM&S-36) at the DMC is well integrated into the hospital system. Residents handle in-patients at 6 different hospitals working with other services and cover 8 different surgical facilities with over 140 podiatric attendings. With a large patient and surgical base, residents have increased responsibilities and high expectations placed on them. Clinical and surgical experience will include elective and trauma, forefoot and rearfoot, pediatric, and diabetic cases. Two busy foot and ankle clinics are supported on site. Advanced trainings are available as elective rotations. Emphasis is placed on participation and publication of research project or case study. Orthopedic Trauma rotation (Detroit Receiving Hospital- area's only Level 1 Trauma Center), Pediatric Orthopedic Surgery rotation (Children's Hospital of Michigan), and all other rotations allow podiatric residents to function as equals to allopathic residents.
