St. Joseph Medical Center PMSR/RRA residency program offers diverse training experiences in podiatric medicine and surgery including forefoot surgery, rearfoot surgery, pediatrics and trauma. With over 20 Podiatrists, you will be exposed to various procedures and fixation techniques (which will require traveling in the greater Houston area). You will spend time in the private offices to experience pre and post op management, consultations, in-office procedures and practice management. Many rotations at St. Joseph will be spent alongside residents and students from UTMB Galveston, UT Houston and Houston Methodist Hospital. We have a very busy Wound Care Center on site with Hyperbaric Chambers which will enrich your training experience. Surgical workshops will be performed at St. Joseph in our cadaver lab complete with imaging. Residents completing this program will be well prepared to successfully pass their board examinations and obtain excellent job opportunities.
