PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The training program is sponsored by NM VA Healthcare System and co-sponsored by Kaiser-Sacramento. One PGY III will go to Kaiser-Sacramento for their third year and the other two will remain at the VAMC in Albuquerque. All sites are designated as PM&S-36 by the Council on Podiatric Medical Education. The NM VA Healthcare System has a "sharing agreement" with Kirtland Air Force base which allows our residents to see young active adults as well as their dependents. The surgery schedule is also very busy and runs 2 full and one 1/2 day per week with add ons as necessary. All residents share call responsibility. Call involves covering the ED, consults and inpatients. Podiatry covers all lower extremity trauma from our emergency department. The program is well rounded but surgically ways toward advanced trauma and reconstruction of the foot, ankle and lower leg.
