PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Very thorough, high-paced program dealing with a full variety of medical and surgical pathologies. Busy 5 day/week clinic from which residents develop superior clinical skills and their surgical cases. All residents exceed surgical requirements for ABPS. Each resident is required to develop a research protocol and to publish during program. Excellent opportunity for student teaching as well as daily interaction with other specialties and residents. Approximately one third of time is spent on external podiatric surgical rotations with numerous practitioners in the Phoenix valley. Graduates of this program have a broad experience with numerous types of podiatric pathologies, all facets of podiatric surgery, and the podiatric/medical training necessary to manage any patient (or complication) encountered in podiatric practice. All residents are board qualified upon completion of training.

As of June19, 2008 the PM&S-36 program has been granted full approval for 3 positons for each of the three years of training.
