PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Well-rounded program. Excellent salary and benefits. This is a 3/3/3 structure with a total of 9 residents and PMSR/RRA certification. St Vincent Hospital is a level 1 trauma center and is a member of Ascension Health which is the largest not-for-profit and Catholic Health Care System. High volume of inpatient care including diabetic foot infections and limb salvage procedures. This is a hospital based and focused program with the opportunity to work at over 15 local surgery centers and hospitals. Monthly academic calendar includes Radiology Rounds, Morbidity and Mortality, Journal Club, Board Review, Cadaver Lab and Quarterly Grand Rounds. Newly established St. Vincent Podiatric Foundation Fund is also available to assist in development of educational experiences. Residents take majority of call in first year, with some second year call and optional third year call. Work closely with the other medical specialties at the hospital. Extensive exposure to forefoot, rearfoot reconstructive, ankle and wound care. Research opportunities available.
