**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The podiatry residency program at Katherine Shaw Bethea (KSB) Hospital encompasses all aspects of podiatry medicine & surgery from clinical management, pre-op, intra-op, & post-op care. Clinical and surgical exposure includes fore-foot and rear-foot reconstruction, pediatrics, fore-foot and rear-foot revision, internal and external fixation, foot and ankle trauma, and total ankle joint replacements.
