The program started in 2010 and is fully approved by CPME as PMSR w added credential in RRA. There is an emphasis on reconstructive forefoot, rearfoot, ankle and lower leg surgery of all types as described above. We are very active with Emergency Room call (including Peds ER) where podiatric attendings cover all pathology below the tibial tuberosity. Residents cover this call at all times. There is ample time for surgery as well as pre/post op clinical mgmt, practice mgmt and ancillary rotations. The director is a member of a large orthopedic group, and office rotations will take place there as well as in podiatric clinics and wound care/limb salvage clinics. There are attendings from multiple desirable programs including Palmetto General, Orlando, JFK, UTHSC, Graduate, DeKalb, Detroit, etc. Foot/ankle. Pediatric and trauma fellowship trained orthopedic attendings as well. This program is best suited for energetic, highly motivated, self driven young physicians with a strong work ethic who are eager to learn to excel in this profession.
