PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This is a new program under provisional approval. The first two residents began July 1, 2010 and we have matched with 2 for July 1 2011. They are extremely busy. There is an emphasis on reconstructive forefoot, rearfoot and ankle surgery of all types as described above. We are very active with Emergency Room call where podiatric attendings cover all pathology below the tibial tuberosity. Residents will cover this call at all times. There is ample time allowed for surgery as well as pre and post op clinical management, practice management and ancillary rotations. The director is a member of both an orthopedic group and office rotations will take place there as well as in podiatric clinics and wound care/limb salvage clinics. There are attendings from multiple well respected, desirable programs including Palmetto General, Florida Hosp East Orlando, JFK, UTHSC, Graduate, etc. This program will be best suited for energetic, highly motivated, self driven young physicians with a strong work ethic who are eager to learn.
