PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Beth Israel Deaconess is a Harvard Med School affiliated teaching hosp. Residents enjoy access to the extensive libraries on campus, clinical skills labs, and cutting edge lectures in all aspects of med and research. The Pod Surg Res Prog is a high volume surg prog that provides exposure to all aspects of foot and ankle surgery, including trauma, reconstructive, elective, and diabetic salvage procedures. PGY-1 Residents are expected to perform at the same level of medicine and surgical interns as the 1st year of training. Thereafter, there is greater exposure to Pod and Ortho surgical cases. Residents are expected to manage in-house patients in addition to running a Residents Clinic during their 1st year. This program is a very hands-on clinical experience with exposure to both Pod & Ortho Attendings. Research opportunities are abundant, including the opportunity to participate in clinical trials, NIH funded research grants, and the necessary support to engage in original research projects.
