**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

Inova Fairfax Hospital, a 833-bed teaching facility, houses Northern Virginia's only Level 1 trauma center and the off-site campus for VCU med school. The residency program is fully integrated within the GME community with podiatric residents functioning as equals to allopathic residents. Strengths of the program include extensive training in reconstructive rearfoot and ankle surgery and limb salvage, a strong didactic program, hands-on medical rotations, a large podiatric and medical teaching staff, a busy in-patient podiatric service, a formalized trauma rotation in conjunction with the orthopedic trauma team plus orthopedic oncology and plastic surgery rotations. At Georgetown U Med Center, residents get extensive hands-on training at the Limb Salvage Center under the auspices of world-renowned plastic and podiatric surgeons. Extensive hands-on clinical training is available at the Kaiser Permanente foot clinic. Opportunities exist for medical missionary work overseas plus rotations at Indian Health Service facilities for extensive training in reconstructive limb salvage surgery.
