PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Geisinger Community Medical Center is a PMSR/RRA certified program involved in all facets of podiatric medicine and surgery. Residents rotate with all specialties and implement wound care practices and Hyperbaric Oxygen therapy in a hospital based wound care center. Strong surgical skills are enforced with excellent guidance from staff Attendings in all aspects of foot and ankle surgery including Charcot reconstruction, rearfoot and forefoot procedures, ankle arthroscopy, Ilizarov frames, limb salvage, and trauma. Private practice and hospital based clinics are included in the curriculum encompassing all aspects of podiatric medicine. Residents experience a strong focus on pediatric pathology and deformity correction during a rotation at the Rubin Institute for Advanced Orthopedics at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. Research and education remains a priority as residents continue to present research at national conferences and publish in multiple print medias each year. An externship is strongly recommended however, not required to be considered as an applicant.
