PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The program is multifaceted and well-rounded. Ranging from rear foot reconstructive ankle surgery utilizing the latest techniques along with all facets of forefoot and midfoot surgery. Resident's are required to have a paper of publishable quality by the time of graduation. There is also a wound care center which will provide training and experience in all phases of diabetic wound management, PVD, neurologic conditions, osteomyelitis and limb preservation. The hospitals consist of 3 divisions(Washington Township, Cherry Hill and Stratford) along with the Kennedy surgical center where surgeries and patient care occurs. The program has currently combined with Foot and Ankle Orthopedics bringing even further diversity in surgical training. We have been appeoved by the CPME and have been re-classified from a PM&S 24 to a PM&S 36 with RRA Certification. COTH and the CPME are moving to a PMSR with RRA certification. Meaning you will have many PM&S 36 programs, however , you will not be able to become certified in rear foot without a RRA certification. We already have been approved.
