Recently expanded PM&S-36 program with 2 entry level positions approved since 7/1/2010. This is a well-rounded PMS-36 surgical program in a large 1300 bed facility. Total 31 residency and fellowship programs. Residents will be thoroughly trained in all facets of podiatric medicine and surgery including diabetic wound care, forefoot and rearfoot and ankle reconstructive surgery, trauma and limb salvage. The hospital has created an on-site podiatry faculty practice giving the podiatry resident the opportunity to comprehensively treat and follow their surgical and non-surgical patients. Recent additions to our training resources include a Wound Care Center, Orthopedic and Pain Management rotations. Outside private office rotations available as well.
