PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Rochester General Hospital, located in Rochester NY, has provisional accreditation for a 36 month podiatric residency program that emphasizes on all aspects of podiatric care from basic clinical experiences to advanced reconstructive procedures. This program began in the 2017-2018 academic year, with PMSR/RRA certification. The program is designed to start our first year similar to a typical internship year, focusing on a comprehensive education while also starting surgical integration that continues to build throughout one's residency experience. Residents are provided with opportunities to learn from top-notch medical and surgical specialists from multiple health care facilities Learning is hands-on and interactive; learning surgery through doing, not watching. In addition to the rich 'hands on' procedural facets of our program, monthly journal club meetings, presentations, and ongoing research opportunities play an important role in keeping our residents current with advances made in the field of podiatric medicine and surgery.
